Be Proactive to lead the Career. 2. How to Select the Product for Manufacturing and business development? 3. <p>Some of the responses from Shri Yatin Shah Sir are as follows</p> <p>Mr.Swaranjal Arora: Q: What did you see, if someone comes with new proposal to you in the organisation? A: The proposal (idea) should be appealing one. I always see it with the financial angle such as: Is it Do-able? Is it scalable? Is it profitable after some duration? , Is it long term? .</p> <p>Mr. Akash Gaikwad: Q: Is there any opportunity in PCL for us? How to crack the interview in PCL? A: Follow five-point formula, discussed during the session and chances will be more to crack any interview not only PCL but also other companies.</p> <p>Prof Bhoge Q: What will be COVID -19 effect on the company and student's employment? A: No definite answer. We don't know when the lockdown period will get over. 45 days closer is</p>	

difficult for the companies to survive. We don't know now how many companies will survive to this lockdown. As no new projects, no new capital, uncertainty about the policies after COVID-19 etc. This is the right opportunity students should do the track of the companies. What is the product of the company, its policies, its turnover, future expansion, personal growth in the company etc. I liked the discussion on the Success PYRAMID.
