Guides of PG students should ensure publishing of one journal paper by the students before the submission their project. Some of our students have completed their projects in the industry. If industry allows publishing the paper based on his/ her work then the concerned guide to publish the same in reputed journals along with the student and the industry mentor. All project guides to identify some of best projects of last few years/ current year and try to publish the papers on it. If faculty members are publishing their papers in these conferences, then their papers will be considered equivalent to UGC/ AICTE journals.
